This warranty applies only to the Laticrete products used on installations in Europe and does not cover application to steel framed structures. Laticrete recommend that the Hardie Wall is installed with the latest published James Hardie installation instructions.

For this limited "system" warranty to apply, the applications that comprise the installation must be performed with the products listed in this document of relevance for each application (refer to chart) and application must follow the guidelines given in each specific product data sheet. LATICRETE reserves the right to update instructions, technical data sheets and other information at any time without notice.

LATICRETE will not pay for replacement of any portion of the installation that is not proven to be defective.
